Yard waste sweep planned for Orange City residents

ORANGE CITY, Fla. — Due to increased vegetative debris from Hurricane Idalia, GFL Environmental, Orange City's contracted waste hauler, will be completing a yard waste sweep of the city on Wednesday, September 6, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Orange City residents should follow regular yard waste guidelines for disposal.

Yard waste should be placed at the curb in a homeowner provided 32- gallon garbage can, tied bundle or plastic or paper bag. Tied and bundled branches and limbs should be no longer than four (4) feet in length and six (6) inches in diameter. Yard waste must weigh less than 50 pounds and be stacked uniformly.

Wood fencing, landscape timbers, flower pots, yard decorations, mulch and dirt are not considered yard waste and will not be collected as a part of this sweep.
