

ORANGE CITY - SOLID WASTE SERVICES

Orange City's Solid Waste Services

This information is applicable for Orange City residents. If your service days differ than the ones listed below, then you are likely serviced by Volusia County and will have different guidelines to follow. Each household in Orange City shall have one trash cart and one recycling cart. The fee for Solid Waste Services is included on each property owner's annual tax bill. Maintenance of the carts is included in the annual fee. Should your carts require maintenance, please call GFL at 386-222-0693. If you encounter any issues working with GLF, please call the city at 386-775-5447.

Automated Collection Services in place:

Orange City contracted with GFL for fully automated garbage and recycling service. This means, all garbage and recycling must be contained inside of the 96-gallon garbage cart or 64-gallon recycling cart. GFL cannot pick up excess garbage and/or recycling that is not contained within the respective cart. If you have excess garbage or recycling, these can be hauled for a fee to be paid by the customer directly to GFL.

ORANGE CITY SERVICE DAYS:

Monday – Garbage and yard waste

Tuesday- Recycling

Items should be placed at the curbside by 6:00 am, the day of scheduled collection service.

Holiday schedule

If household solid waste collection falls on a holiday when the landfill is closed, collection will occur on the following business or next calendar day. Currently, there can be no collection services on the following holidays, as the landfill is closed.

- New Year's Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

You can do your part:

To help collection stay on schedule, please follow these steps:

- Place items at the curb by **6 am**, the day of the scheduled collection service.
- Place the wheels of the carts toward the house and the arrow on the carts should be pointed toward the street.
- Place the carts **away from other objects**. There should be at least **2 feet** between all other items (mail boxes, bushes, telephone poles, parked vehicles, other garbage or recycling containers).

RECYCLING:

Items you CAN recycle in your 64-gallon recycling cart (all must be clean and dry):

Never bag your recyclables – place them directly in the 64-gallon recycling cart.

- Aluminum, steel and tin cans
- Plastic bottles and jugs (with or without caps)
- Paper, cardboard and newspaper

Items you CANNOT recycle:

- Glass (Glass can be dropped off at a Volusia County recycling sites)
- Plastic bags, plastic toys, plasticware
- Items contaminated with food
- Styrofoam
- Batteries
- Light bulbs
- discarded electric cords or appliances
- discarded clothing

YARD WASTE DISPOSAL:

Residents are required to tie, bag or bundle yard waste. Yard waste can be placed at the curb in a plastic or paper bag or in a home-owner provided container. Yard trash is limited to a maximum of four (4) cubic yards or ten (10) bags per residence per week. Branches and limbs should be no longer than four (4) feet in length and six inches in diameter, must be less than 50 pounds, tied in bundles or contained. Palm fronds must be stacked uniformly.

Items not considered yard waste: wood fencing, landscape timbers, flower pots, yard decorations, mulch and dirt.

WHITE GOODS (Appliances)/ BULK ITEMS: Residents can call the numbers below and schedule a collection for household appliances. These items are limited to four (4) cubic yards per week and must be able to be lifted by two people. Items exceeding these requirements can be hauled for a fee to be paid by the customer directly to GFL.
