The City of Orange City is pleased in your help to spread some holiday cheer this year by sponsoring a Christmas tree at Dickinson Park. This year the parks departments will transform Dickinson Park into a festival of trees. This is where we need you. Throughout Dickinson Park we would like to display your tree while promoting your business. This is sure to bring lots of smiling faces and it is a way to make our park shine for families to enjoy this Christmas.

Completed applications are required for the participation in this program. Specific themes are suggested and must be submitted as part of the application. Themes cannot be changed once approved. No tree themes will be accepted which are political or controversial.

Program Details:

- 1. Set up of your tree must take place the week of 11/18-11/27 at Dickinson Park. Power will be provided and your designated location will be marked so you know where to set up your tree.
- 2. We have designated twenty locations for tree entries. Each tree entry is first come first serve. There is no fee to participate.
- 3. We request an artificial tree. Trees should be 6-8 feet in height. If over 8 ft please note on the application so we can provide the best location for a larger tree.
- 4. We will have the power turned on in the park to help you in your set up. We ask that you disconnect the power at the bottom of your tree once complete as we will light all trees on our big reveal day on 12/2.
- 5. Recommendations about lights: If you are not using LED light please note that if you plug in more than 4 light strands it can blow your lights. We suggest using LED lights but it is not required.
- 6. Trees must be removed from the park by January 3rd. If they are not picked up they will become the property of the City to use for future events.
- 7. The City of not responsible for items lost or stolen from the trees. We suggest using small zip ties or wire to secure ornaments to the tree to prevent removal. Please ensure the trees are secure to the ground to prevent them from toppling over. Park staff are available Monday through Friday 7AM-2PM if you need help in securing the tree.
- 8. The City will provide all trees with a sign listing your business name which will take place the week of 11/28. Until the City puts the official signs on the tree please make sure to provide the name of the business somewhere on the tree so we can match it to the application.

- 10. Join us 12/2 for the official kick off of the festival of trees during our Light Up event at 5PM along with the Mayor and City Council as we light up the park along with City Hall.
